THE SCHOOL CAMPUS

Functional in two acres of land at Sasane Nagar. The 4 storeyed building has 34 rooms with 3 Science Laboratories, Library, Computer Lab, AV Room, Auditorium & a big playground. In addition to this, a 4 storeyed new building with 12 class rooms is functional from June 2013.

The school follows the syllabus as prescribed by Maharashtra State Board of Education. The Medium of instruction is English.

HISTORY OF OUR SCHOOL

- Sasane Education Society established New English School at Hadapsar in 1985.
- Initially the school was running in an old dilapidated Wada with classes 1st to 4th with a total strength of 80 students and 2 teachers.
- Later on in 1991 a 3 storeyed building with 18 class-rooms was constructed. There were about 1200 students, 40 teaching and non-teaching staff by then.
- By 2015 the strength increased to 2000 students with 110 staff members (teaching & non teaching staff) & started functioning in the present 4 storeyed building.
- A second building with 4 floors & 12 class-rooms has been constructed at the same premises. Pre-Primary & Primary sections conduct their classes in this building from the academic year (2013-14).
- The school has well equipped Science Laboratories, Computer Laboratory, Library, Spacious Ground and Transport facilities.
- To add a feather in the cap, we have started Arts, Commerce & Science Jr. College (English Medium) from the academic year 2013-14. All this has been possible due to the able guidance of the Management, co-operation from the parents, dedicated staff & students.

AIM

- The aim of our School is to train the students educationally and build foundation for the national progress.
- To create happy and caring school environment, in which the children learn that courtesy, good manners and consideration for others are valued qualities.
- To develop helpful learning attitudes, useful learning skills and with continuity and progression, to increase the child's knowledge and understanding.
- To teach the children to communicate effectively, both in spoken and written English, for a variety of purposes, with an appropriate emphasis on handwriting, spelling, grammar and punctuation.
- To develop knowledge, understanding of basic mathematical operations and the ability to apply these appropriately.
- To encourage scientific curiosity and to improve the children's skills and knowledge in Science and Technology, and to further develop their use of Information Technology throughout the curriculum.
- To awaken and create awareness of the world around us through historical, geographical and scientific studies.
- To develop the children's abilities and enjoyment in physical activities including games.
- To promote equal opportunities for everyone regardless of gender, race or ability.
- To promote close liaison with parents, governors and the local community.
- To inculcate moral values as a personal choice and to weigh moral values with an upright conscience.

The School will normally start functioning in the 2nd week of June every year. The academic sessions are divided into two terms as given.

1. New students will be admitted to Nursery and also to the upper classes, as per rules and their previous record. Parents/Guardians are requested to attach the following documents with the prescribed form.

- ✓ School Leaving Certificate (for upper classes)
- ✓ Caste Certificate for SC, ST, VJNT, OBC, SBC (if applicable)
- ✓ Photocopy of Aadhaar Card

The original birth certificate submitted to the school will not be returned and shall remain on the record of the school.

2. Admission for Nursery will be granted only to those boys and girls who will complete 2nd years of their age on 1st June of the academic year.

3. Counter Signature of the Education Officer on the T.C./L.C., if the child is not from Pune district.

WITHDRAWAL

1. No leaving Certificate will be issued unless the parents or guardians makes a request in writing in the prescribed form.

2. One month's notice for withdrawal is necessary.

3. No leaving certificate will be issued until all fees, fine and other dues of the school are paid.

1. Up to 8th standard, there will be two examinations and periodic tests will be conducted throughout the year for 10 marks each. For Standard IX and X examinations, please refer the school calendar.

2. Unfair means in examination may result in the student getting zero marks in the subject or if repeated, dismissal from the school.

RECOMMENDATION TO THE PARENTS

- The School expects the co-operation from the parents to ensure :
 - That the children come to school regularly, punctually and dressed neatly.
 - That the children bring to school their books and note books, which are properly maintained.
 - That the children do their home work regularly.
 - From time to time, come to the office and find out about their children's progress.
- Occasional report from teachers are conveniently made in the school calendar. Parents are requested to sign them as a proof that they have gone through the reports.
- When parents are required to see the Principal regarding any complaint, they should comply as early as possible.
- Parents and Guardians are not allowed to see pupils or interview teacher during class hours without permission of the Principal in advance.
- Parents and Guardians are specially requested to adhere, strictly the rules, regulations and help the school to enforce discipline and regularity to build good habits and character in their children.

- Promotions are decided on the pupil's progress throughout the year based on the results of terminal and final examinations and remedial tests, if required.
- Promotions will be made only at the end of the academic year on the result of the examination. Promotion once refused will not be reconsidered under any circumstances. For Standard IX, please refer the school calendar.

LEAVE ABSENCE

- Parents should realize the importance of foundation classes, which begins from Playgroup and so the Children should not be distracted from regular, planned routine of their lessons.
- No child may leave the school premises during school hours without the permission of the Principal or Class-Teacher.
- In case of sickness, intimation must be given to the office immediately in writing. Absence over 3 days requires a medical fitness certificate from a qualified medical practitioner.
- The date of opening and closing of school must be strictly observed.

DISCIPLINE

- A Pupil must be present in school on the last working day as well as re-opening day, failing which a fine of Rs. 50/- for the first day and thereafter Rs. 10/- per day will be charged for subsequent days.
- A Pupil must be regular in attendance and should come on time in the school.
- Children must come in clean and complete uniform.
- Absence due to sickness shall be supported by Medical Certificate from a qualified Medical Practitioner.
- Pupil suffering from infectious diseases will not be allowed to attend the school. After recovery, fitness certificate from qualified Medical Practitioner must be produced.
- Girls are expected to come with hair neatly combed and plaited or tied, if long, with black ribbon only. (Also, compulsorily use hair bands). Hair should not fall over the forehead. No cash, mobiles, transistors, jewellery to be brought to school. School will not be responsible if they are lost. (Bindi, Bangles, Mahendi, Payal will not be allowed for girls).
- Boys will cut their hair regularly (Soldier Cut).
- For safety precautions school is under constant CCTV surveillance.
